Affiliated with UCLA's David Geffen School of Medicine and partnered with Harbor-UCLA Medical Center, our investigators consistently make breakthroughs that change how we prevent, detect, and treat disease.

Our research is funded by a diverse range of sources, including grants from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) and other government agencies, industry contracts, corporate sponsorships, pharmaceutical royalties, private philanthropy, and foundation support. Past supporters include the Amgen Foundation, Morgan Stanley Foundation, Capital Group Companies, and the California Community Foundation, among others.

Her discoveries including the link between Kaposi sarcoma in HIV infected patients and Castlemen's disease, and the presence of HIV in stem cells of the bone marrow, have improved the lives of patients living with HIV.



Dr. Emil Kakkis Pediatric Rare Diseases

His research on rare diseases led to the creation and commercialization of Aldurazyme, a lifesaving enzyme replacement therapy. Dr. Kakkis is currently President and Chief Executive Officer of Ultragenyx.
